Over the last decade the Piemonte Region has brought about an organizational change directed to the enhancement of primary care facilities and the implementation of integrated care pathways, in order to avoid useless or inappropriate hospitalisations for patients. This new organisational model implied the 'reconversion' of smaller hospitals into primary care facilities (CAP).

- Started in 2005 with a few students as an experimental academic programme.....
- 2012-2013: Active part of the *AA3 Workforce Development* (in AG B3)
- Presented as a GOOD PRACTICE in 2012 in EIP, within the context of the PIEMONTE RS
- 2014 - 2015: SCALED-UP at regional and interregional level: > 140 students got their degree
- 2015 – 2016: SCALED-UP through 2 financed EU PROJECTS: SUNFRAIL and CON.SEN.SO

*(Università di Torino - Pharmacy)* ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Local network of stakeholders created
- Commitment website created
- Website accessible to >65 citizens for information on the correct use of medicines
- Pharmacy students actively involved
- EU projects partnership creation
- Documents produced within AG A1 in EIP-AHA

*(Università di Torino - Psychology)* ACHIEVEMENTS:

- longitudinal (1-year) assessment of frailty in Italian community dwelling older adults;
- Cross-cultural adaptation and validation of the Italian version of the Tillburg Frailty Indicator;
- Development of a technological tool to assess objective parameter to assess frailty;
- Validation of a mathematical tool based on Dynamic Systems to simulate trajectories of Health Related Quality of Life;
- Development and validation of a multifactorial intervention program;
- Development and validation of a dual task intervention program.
