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# Erasmus+ contributing to wider EU goals



## Inclusion and diversity

Increasing the qualitative impact of its actions and to ensure **equal opportunities**.

Reaching out to people of **different ages and from diverse cultural, social and economic backgrounds**.

Focus on people with fewer opportunities, including those with disabilities, educational difficulties, or a migrant background, as well as those living in rural and remote areas.



## Digital Erasmus+

Aligned with the **Digital Education Action Plan's priorities**, develop accessible and high-quality digital learning, foster the capacity of teachers, trainers and youth workers, etc. to use digital tools and content, test and promote **distance, as well as blended learning**.

The implementation of the programme will be significantly digitalised and **simplified** for participants.



## Green Erasmus+

Aligned with the **European Green Deal**, the programme will encourage participants to use lower carbon transport as an alternative to flying.

Build up knowledge and **understanding of sustainability and climate action**, so that Europeans acquire the world-leading competences needed to create sustainable societies, lifestyles and economies.

### Support to policy development and cooperation

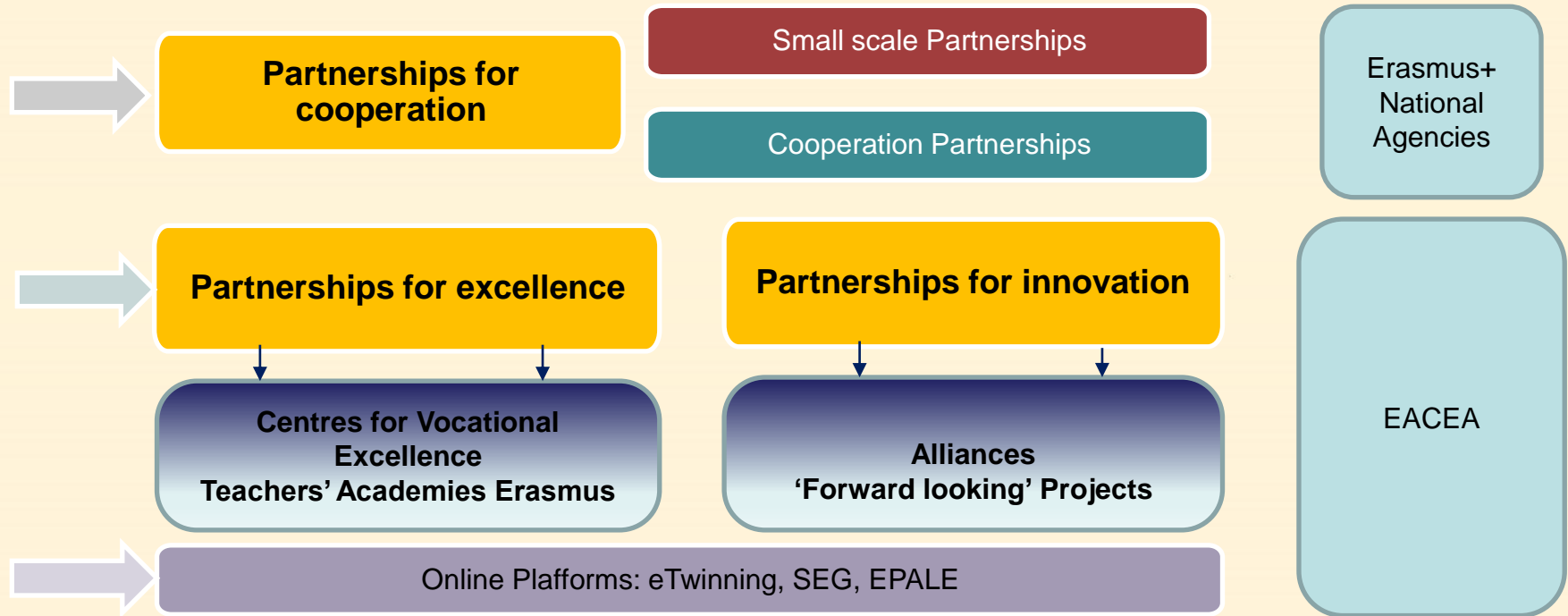
- Preparation and implementation of the EU general and sectoral policy agenda in education and training:

  - Cooperation with **international organisations**



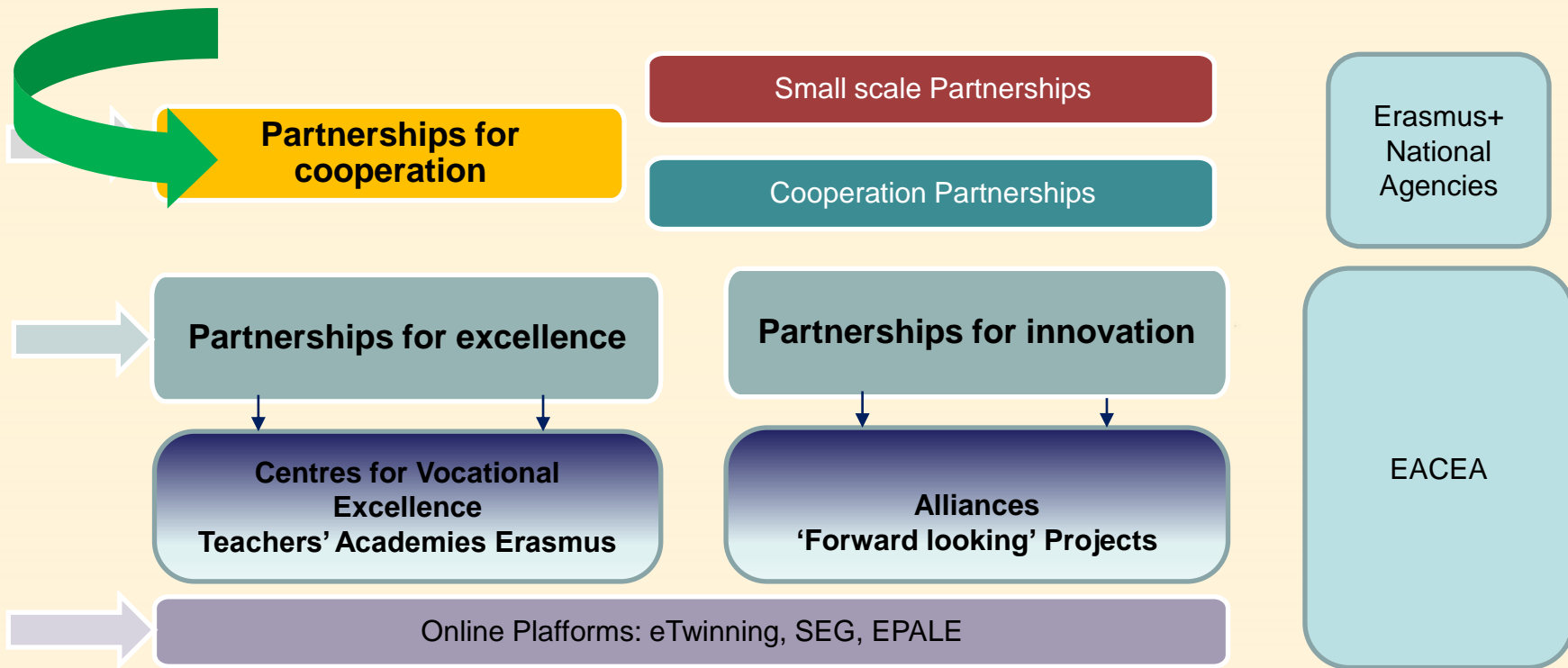

# Partnerships for cooperation (Ka2)

## Priorities applying to all sectors in AWP 2022

- Increasing the **flexibility** of opportunities
- Contributing to **innovation**
- Increasing **attractiveness** of VET
- Improving **quality assurance**
- Creation and implementation of **internationalisation strategies**





# Partnerships for cooperation (Ka2)

## *Cooperation partnerships*

### **Purpose:**

- **Build capacity** of organisations to work transnationally and across sectors;
- **Increase quality of activities and practices** of organisations and institutions involved;
- Address **common needs and priorities**;
- Enable **transformation and change**

**Grant:** amounts from €120.000 to €400.000 according to the activities to undertake and results to achieve

**Duration:** Project duration **between 12 and 36 months**



# Partnerships for cooperation (Ka2)

## *Small scale partnerships*

**Purpose:** **Attract and widen access for newcomers**, less experienced organisations and small-scale actors to the programme

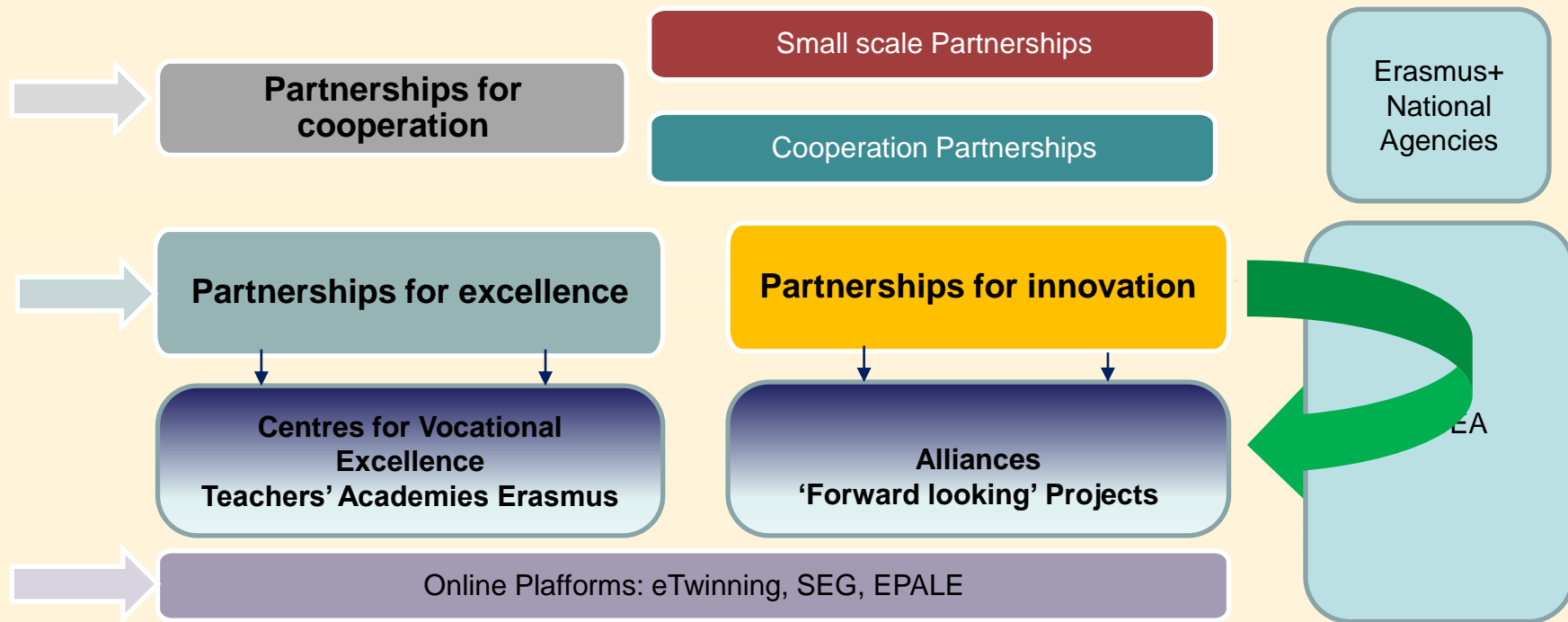
**Advantages:** **Easier access** for grass-root organisations and newcomers, and **easier application process** and simpler projects' implementation (2 deadlines in 2022)

**Grant:** Applicants will choose between two pre-defined amounts of **€30 000 or €60 000** according to the activities to undertake and results to achieve

**Duration:** Project duration **between 6 and 24 months**

# Forward-looking projects (KA 2) Deadline 15 March

## Lot 1: Cross-sectoral priorities (€27 million)

Priority 1: Supporting high quality and inclusive digital education, in line with the aims of the Digital Education Action Plan.

Priority 2: Supporting education and training systems to adapt for the green transition

# Partnerships for Innovation (Ka2) - Alliances for Innovation

## Lot1 Alliances for Education and Enterprises (€30 million)

### Aims:

- Innovative and multidisciplinary approaches to teaching and learning
- Corporate social responsibility
- Sense of initiative and entrepreneurial attitudes, mindsets and skills (Entrecomp)
- Quality and relevance of skills
- Flow and co-creation of knowledge
- VET and HE systems > Innovation



**Grant:** €1.000.000 for 2 year projects,  
€1.500.000 for 3 year projects



# Partnerships for Innovation (Ka2) - Alliances for Innovation

## Lot2 Alliances for Sectoral Cooperation on skills "Blueprint" (€32 million)

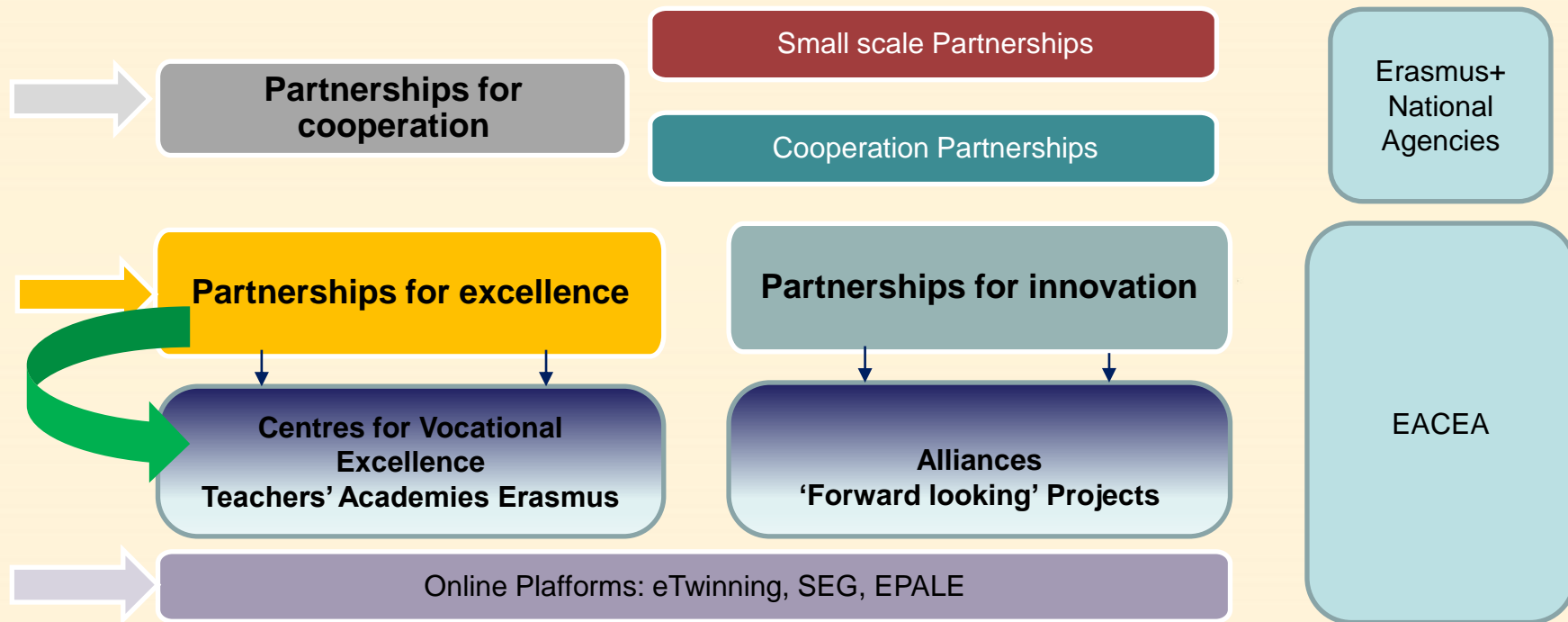
### Characteristics:

- Large sector-based Europe-wide projects tackling skills gaps
- Must cover lower and higher VET levels: EQF 3-5 and 6-8;
- Sectors: 14 industrial ecosystems of the Industrial Strategy
- Synergies with sectoral partnerships under the Pact for Skills
- Drawing on evidence on skills needs in occupational profiles
- Support the design and delivery of transnational education and training content for quick take-up at regional and local level and for emerging occupations

**Grant:** €4.000.000 for 4 year projects

# Partnerships for Excellence (Ka2)

## Centres of Vocational Excellence (2022 Budget €48 million)

- **Applicant:** Any organisation established in a Programme Country
- **Partners:** Any public or private organisation active in field of VET, or world of work. Can be from any country in the world, but non-programme partners must bring an 'essential added value'
- **Activities:** 3 clusters
- **Partnership:** at least 8 full partners from a minimum of 4 Programme
  - a) at least 1 enterprise, industry or sector representative organisation, and
  - b) at least 1 VET provider (at secondary and/or tertiary level)
- **EQF levels:** Can be at any EQF level but must include levels 3, 4 or 5
- **Maximum grant:** €4 million per project with 4 year project duration
