Strategic relevance with regard to the EU Health Strategy and with regard to expected contribution to existing knowledge and implications for health

Note	Comments
8/8	This proposal emphasizes two main strategic points. It is set out to contribute to sustainable development and Europe 2020 and to create EU added value. The Joint Action adds value to the existing public health knowledge as <u>it will probably allow the practical use of that knowledge in the field</u> . <u>The contribution to the existing knowledge is done mainly through the development of the best-practices collection</u> . The Joint Action is also expected to contribute to EU policies and to have a positive implication for the health of the whole concerned population in Europe. The proposal illustrates ways of reproducibility and transferability of actions that are planned and addresses sustainability after the end of the JA.

Added value at EU level in the field of public health

Note	Comments
8/8	Due to the nature of the expected contributions to solving mental health issues, there is a great expectation that this type of coordination will be greater than the work or impact of individual Member States. <u>Another expectation is that this JA will contribute towards the development of EU policies and regulations, standardization across MS. The elements and tools to add value are taken into consideration and presented: impact on target groups, long-term effect, multiplier effects, replicability, transferability and sustainable activities.</u> The level of complementarity and synergy is considered to be very high. Therefore, <u>the Joint Action will contribute to the implementation of EU policies and will enable to address problems that would otherwise not be sufficiently addressed by the Member States individually.</u> It would certainly have a significant long-term and multiplier effect on MS in the field of mental health.

Pertinence of geographical coverage

Note	Comments
8/8	The applicant ensures that a geographical coverage of the action is appropriate with regard to its objectives. <u>A sufficient number of organizations from different EU Member States and candidate countries will be involved in the Joint Action. The JA will cover most of the EU geographical area plus Croatia.</u> There is <u>strong emphasis on creating multi-country working groups and the establishment of national working groups.</u> The roles of eligible countries are appropriately described as well as the EU wide target population.
