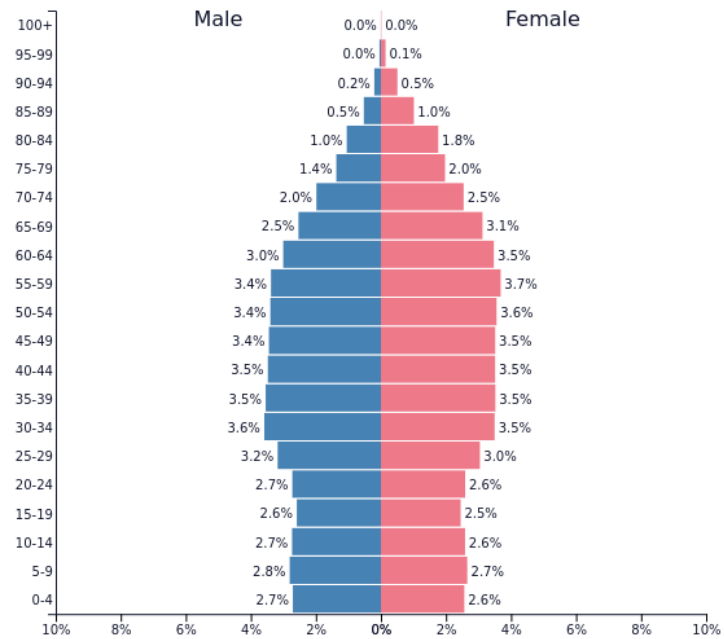

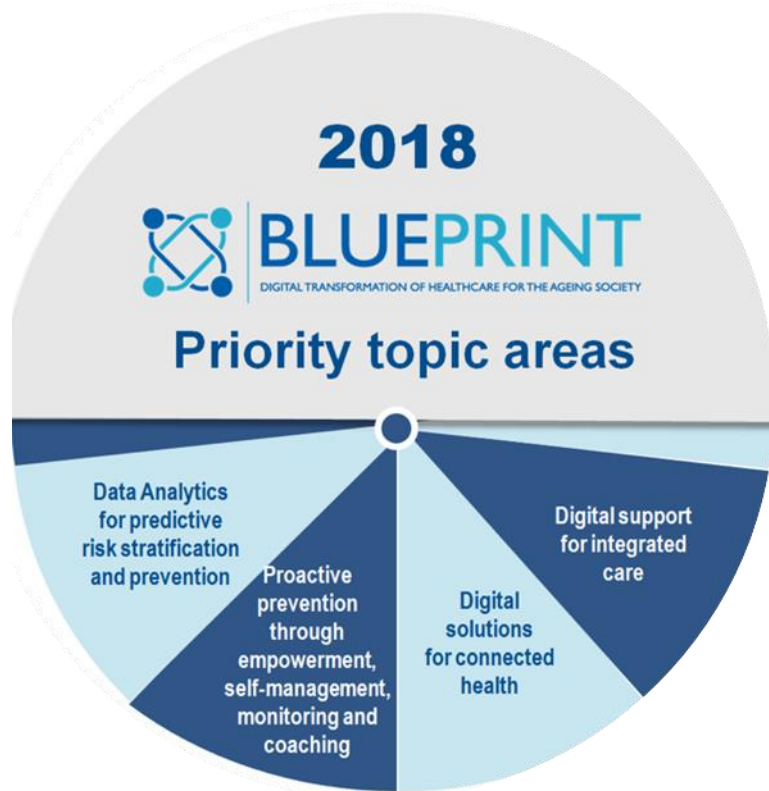

- Established in 2013 following 1st Call for Reference Sites
 - Bottom Up initiative by Reference Sites for Reference Sites
 - Supported by Commission
 - 39 original Reference Site Members
- 2nd Call for Reference Sites 2016
 - Policy and criteria for Reference Sites developed by RSCN
 - 74 Reference Site Members
- 3rd Call for Reference Sites 2019
 - 104 Reference Site Members
- Became a legal entity (ASBL) under Belgian Law November 2017

The eHealth Stakeholder Group is relaunched

On 13 July the Commission held the first meeting of the recently relaunched eHealth Stakeholder Group, as an on-line event. The group will support the Commission in the development of actions for the digital transformation of health and care in the EU.

The eHealth Stakeholder Group will provide advice and expertise to the Commission, particularly on topics set out in the [Communication on enabling the digital transformation of health and care in the Digital Single Market](#), that was adopted in April 2018. In particular in relation to the following areas:

- Health Data, including taking [forward the Commission Recommendation on a European Electronic Health record exchange format](#) and the further elaboration of the baseline set of technical specifications and better interoperability
- Digital health services
- Health data protection and privacy issues
- Cybersecurity for health and care data
- Digital tools for citizen empowerment and person centred care
- Artificial intelligence and health
- Other cross cutting aspects linked to the digital transformation of health and care, such as financing and investment proposals and enabling technologies

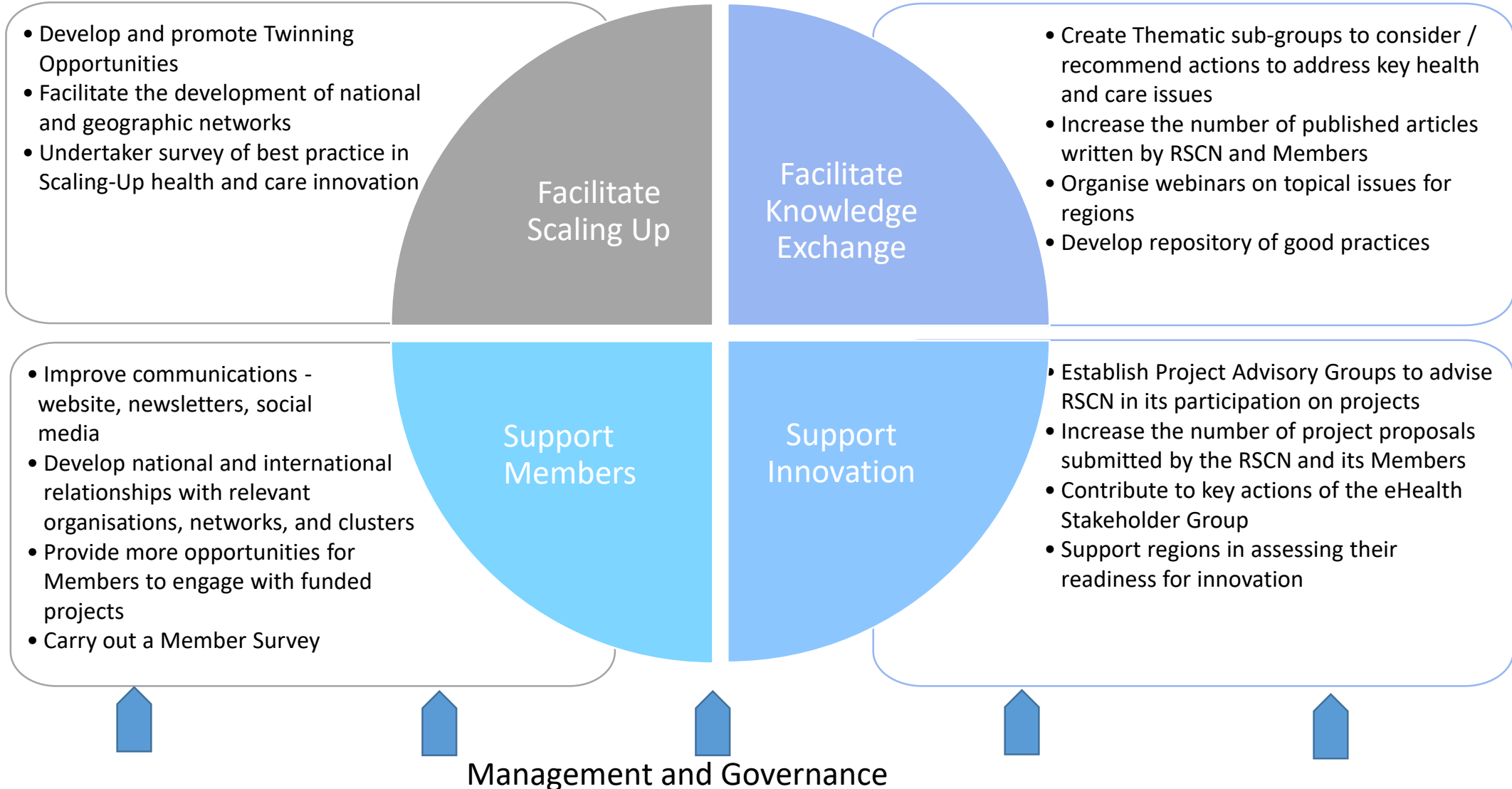
