

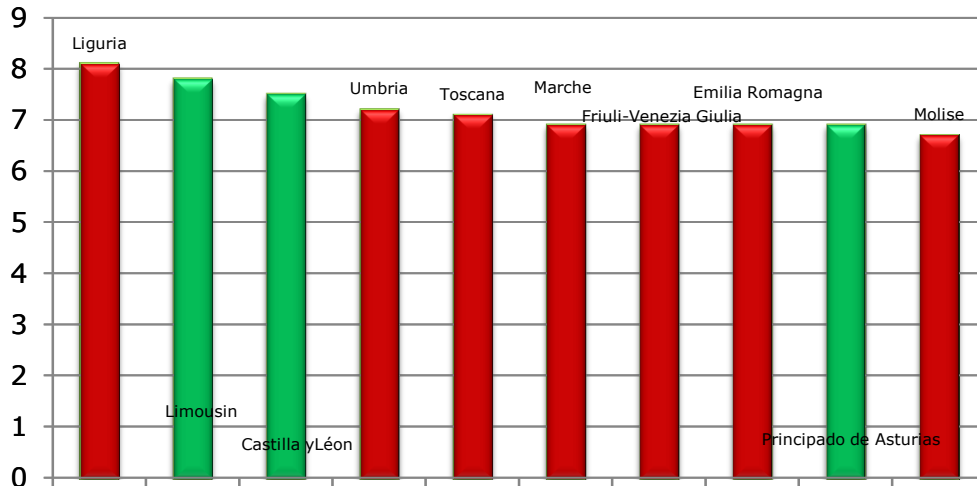

1 Gennaio 2009**



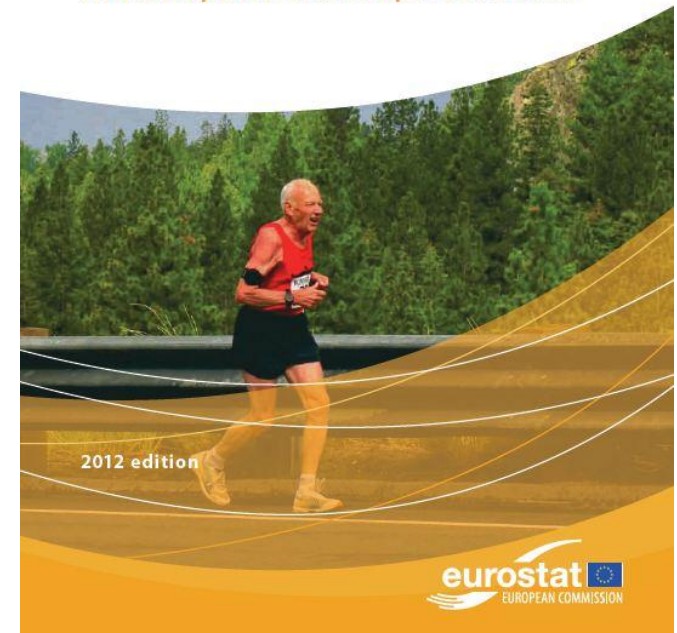
Nel 2010 circa il 40% della popolazione italiana aveva già un'età superiore ai 50 anni. Più nel dettaglio

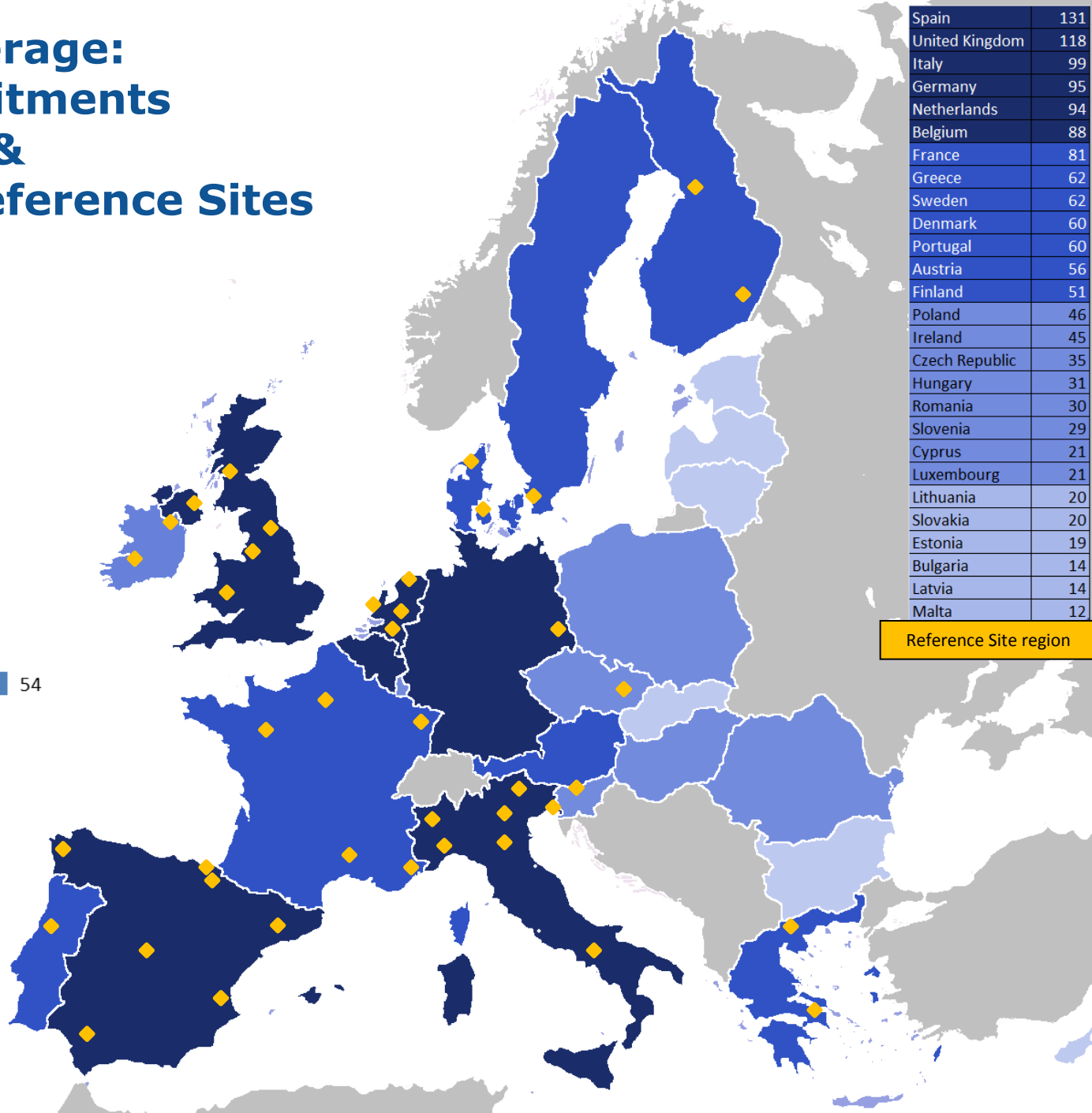

A1 – Prescription and Adherence

Develop and test assessment tools for the identification of individual problems in adhering to medical plans and medication, both in community and in hospital settings.

- ⇒ Software programmes for 65+ diabetic and multi-morbidity patients.
- ⇒ Decision support tools and tele-monitoring devices



A2 – Personalised Health Management – Falls prevention

Inventory of best practice evidence based models of training and training tools, adapted for various groups of work force, and training tools in use

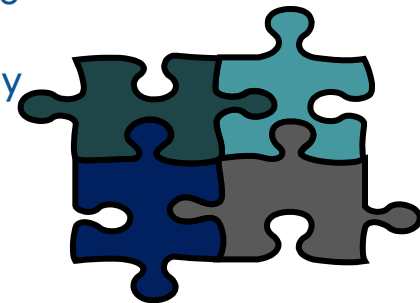
- ⇒ incl. e-learning, applied gaming and internet portals

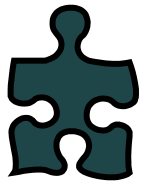


A3 – Prevention of functional decline and frailty

Validated global short screening, triage and assessment tools to prevent, detect and delay frailty

- ⇒ User-friendly, sensitive and specific screening tool for early diagnosis of functional decline
- ⇒ New tools to measure risk of adverse outcomes in community dwelling





B3 – Integrated Care

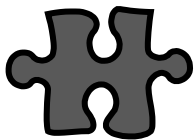

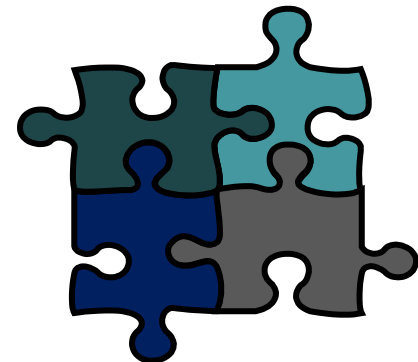
C2 – Interoperable independent living solutions

Potential funding opportunities for Active & Healthy Ageing

7th Framework Programme (FP7): More than € 4 billion available in the last calls (July 2012) potentially relevant for societal challenge such as ageing and/or EIP priorities.



Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme (CIP): ICT part of CIP has allocated €24 Million in the Work Programme 2012 for actions directly relevant for the EIP.



Second Health Programmes: In the last call (closed in March) € 4 million for the EIP on AHA.

Current (examples) and new funding opportunities in the coming months (1st Semester 2013)

PROGRESS: Call for proposals for Social Policy experimentation – It intends to improve the quality and effectiveness of social policies and to facilitate their adaptation to new social needs and societal challenges (deadline 15 February 2013)

Lifelong Learning (Grundtvig - Adult Education): to respond to the educational challenge of an ageing population in Europe. Grundtvig Multilateral Projects are undertaken by institutions/organisations from different participating countries working together, pooling knowledge and experience, in order to achieve concrete and innovative results/products. Among the priorities there is also promoting new forms of literacy to facilitate active participation in modern society, learning for healthy living (deadline 31 January 2013)

FP7 Capacities (European Prize for Innovation in Public Administration): award up to nine Prizes for Innovation in Public Administration following a contest. The prizes will reward excellence and innovation in successful, already running, and innovative public initiatives managed by any national, regional or local public administrations from EU Member States or Associated Countries of the Research Framework Programme (deadline 15 February 2013)



Current (Examples) and **new funding opportunities** in the coming months (1st Semester 2013)

Public Health Programme: Joint Action addressing chronic diseases and promoting ageing across the life style.

WP1 – A system for the collection, validation and dissemination of good practises to address chronic conditions

WP2 - Diabetes: a case study on barriers to prevention, screening and treatment of diabetes and improvement of cooperation among Member States to act on diabetes

WP3 - Development of common guidance and methodologies for care pathways for multi-morbid patients

Public Health Programme: Project grants will foster pilot actions at local level focusing on the management of multimorbidity among elderly people through integrated care pathways, as well as improving adherence to treatment and prevention of falls and frailty.

Ambient Assisted Living Joint Programme (AAL): Call 6 of the AAL JP aims at funding the development of ICT-based solutions which enable older adults to continue managing their occupation – at work in an office or a factory (or any working environment), in a first or subsequent new second or third careers, in paid or voluntary occupation – while preserving health and motivation to remain active (Foreseen for January 2013)

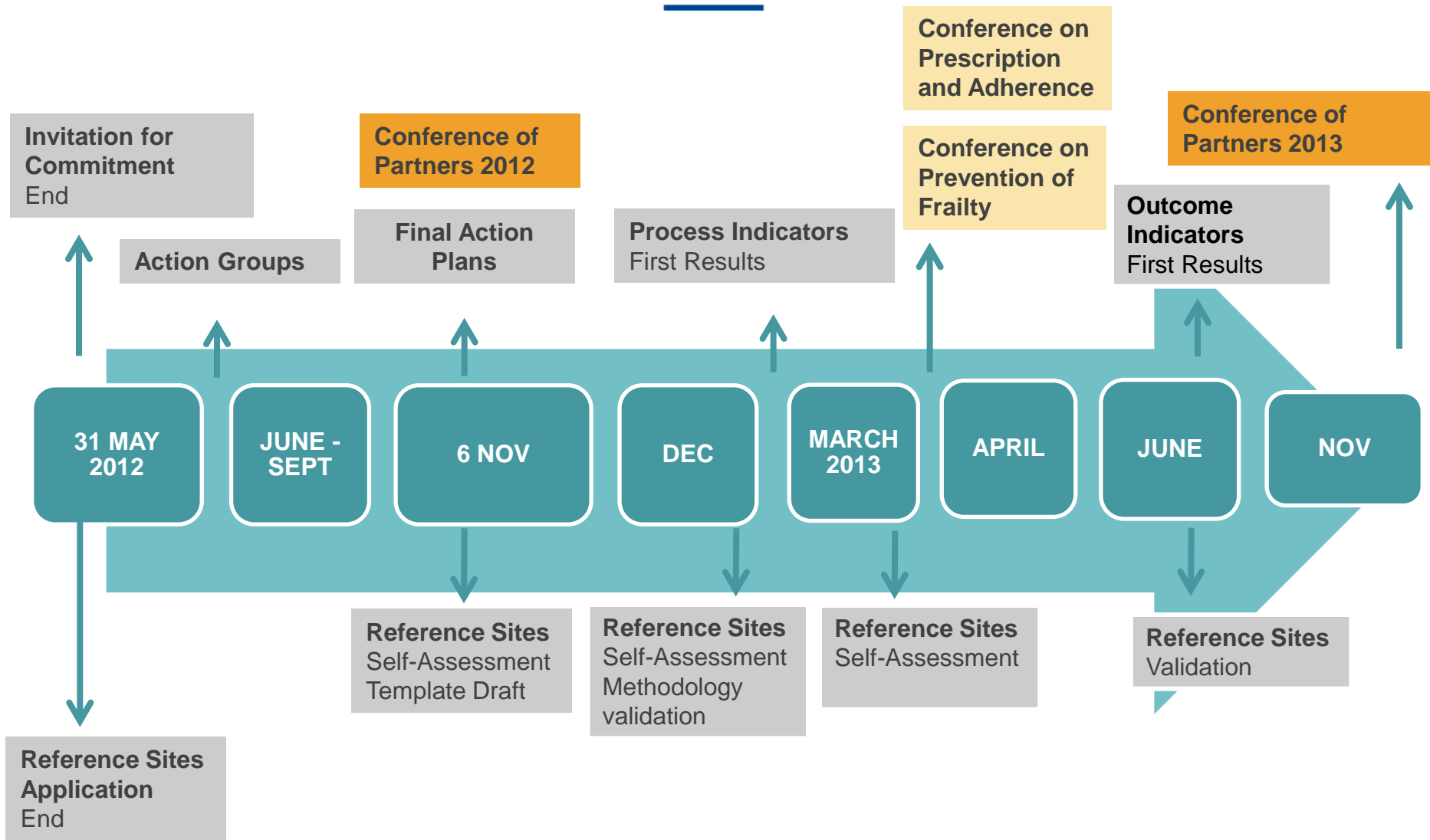
CIP - ICT Policy Support Programme: "Theme 3" focuses on ICT for Health, ageing well and inclusion. It foresees activities on telehealth,
