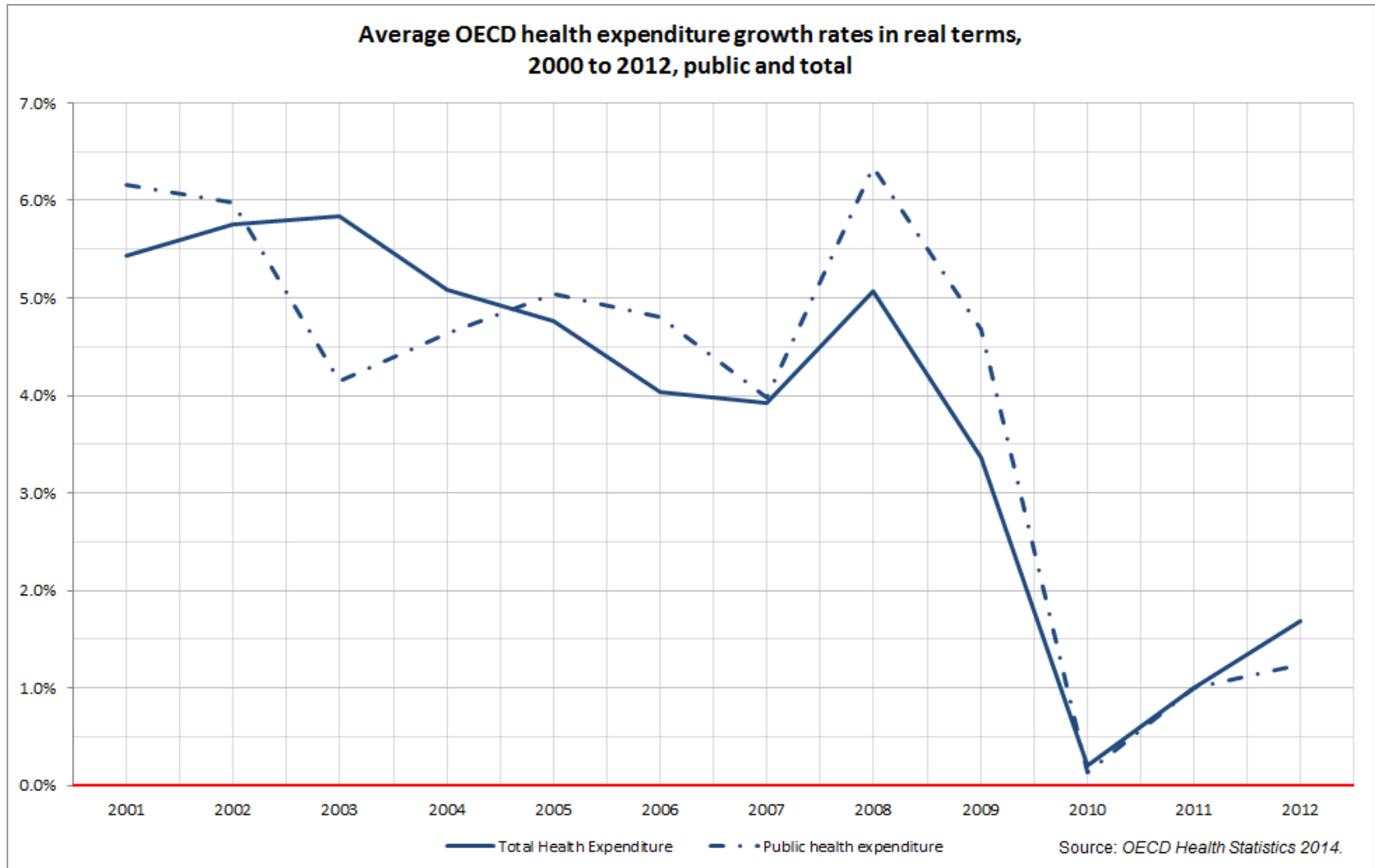

International experiences and future perspectives

- OECD has been developing, testing and using around 50 health care quality indicators since 2002 (HCQI program)
- Reporting since 2007, analytical work since 2010 (cancer, CVD, information infrastructure strengthening, practice variation, country reviews on quality of care)
- HCQI are used broadly in national performance reports
- Off 2015 work will commence on Hospital Performance
