





How do synergies unfold?




Complementary funding: bringing together funding from different programmes or different levels in the same project



- Visibility and communication of cross-programme synergetic results






Single Market Programme – Food Safety



- Prevention of food waste and fight against fraud
- Sustainable and resilient production of food
- Effectiveness and reliability of official **controls** along the food chain
- Contribution to the EU 'Farm to Fork' targets



- Fight against antimicrobial resistance (AMR)
- Improvement of animal welfare across the EU






