Maastricht Treaty 1992 (which created the European Union)

- introduced public health into the founding treaty
- legal basis for adoption health policy measures

EU level health programme

- Idea originates from 1993
- EC published a framework for action > 8 areas for action

e.g. health promotion, cancer, drugs & rare diseases

• predecessor multi-annual public health programmes

Amsterdam Treaty 1997

- strengthened legal/regulatory provisions
- health protection & healthcare systems remained competence Member States



Legal basis

- Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union TFEU
- Article 168 protection of public health
- Article 153 social policy
- Article 114 single market

EU public health policy aims to

- **Protect & improve the health of EU citizens**
- Improve the resilience of Europe's health systems
- Equip EU countries to better prevent & address future pandemics
- Support modernisation & digitalisation health systems + infrastructure


Recent developments






Transformation approach
