Re-skilling and upskilling of workforce

- LTC workforce planning and forecasting
- Training and adaptation of the LTC workforce
- Actions to enhance the attractiveness of the LTC professions
- Offer young people work experience in LTC
- Support career advancement of the workforce
- Support good working conditions
- Contribute to the training and validation of skills and competences of informal carers



Expanding access and coverage

- Improve or expand LTC in those regions where services are underdeveloped
- Improve patients' empowerment
- Support the collection of data and indicators on care-dependent people
- Ensure the availability of appropriate LTC staff





Supporting integrated health and social services

- Support independent living
- Transition from hospital-based care to communitybased care services
- More person-centred approaches to care





Active and healthy ageing

- Implementation of national active ageing strategies
- Strengthen actions of prevention and early diagnosis
- Ensure quality and affordable care services for dependent persons (including in residential care)



Malta programme extends mental health lifeline

A comprehensive package to people experiencing mental health problems: early diagnosis and targeted support



Day-care centers help older persons meet day-to-day needs

KIFI centres are open structures of hospitality and care for older persons who find themselves unable to take care of themselves independently



Independent living for people with intellectual disabilities

In Greece, Axizo project aims to improve participants' quality of life by giving them comprehensive healthcare, education, daily care and support in live autonomously
