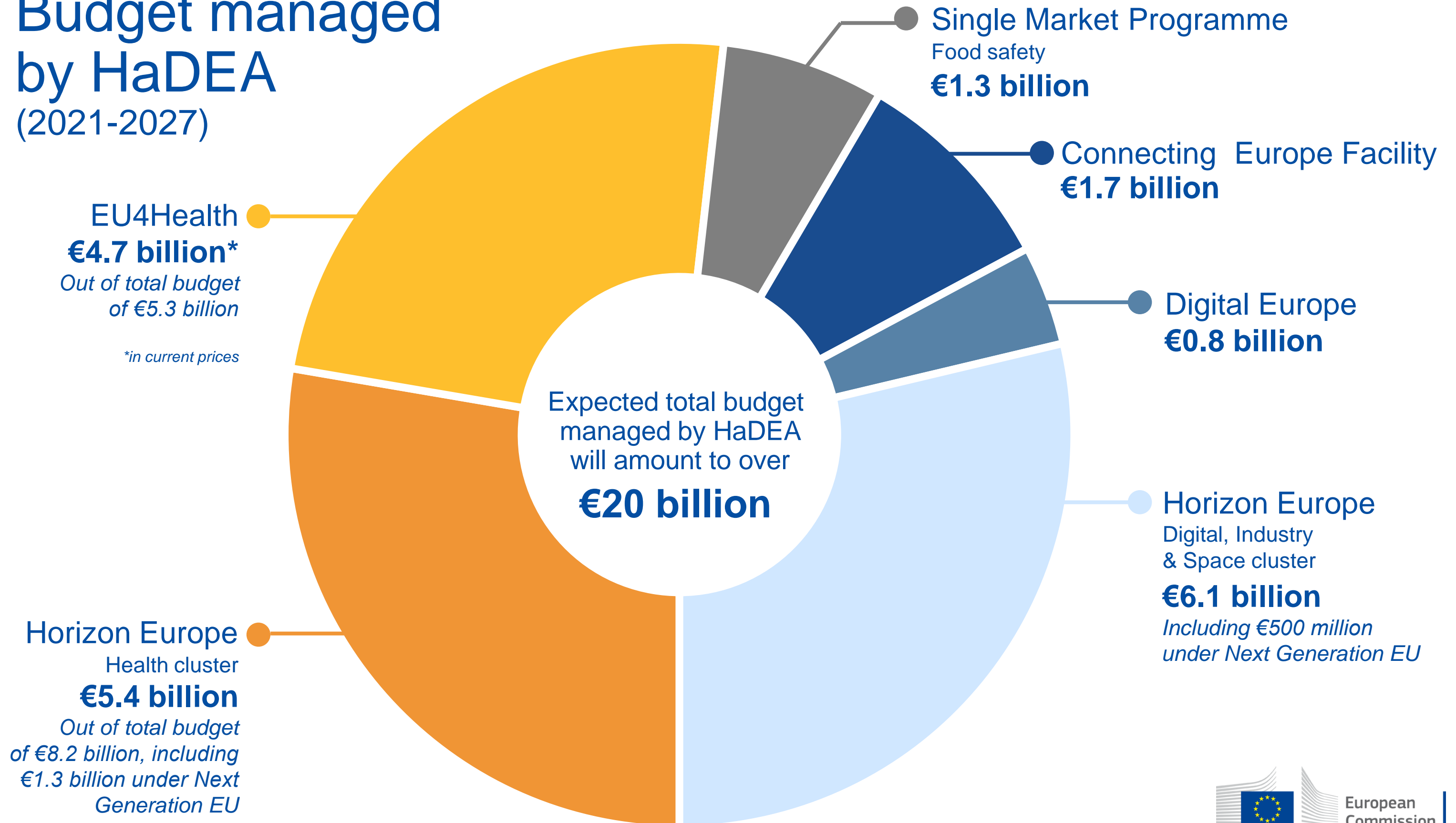

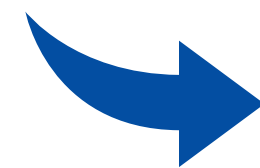

- Strong collaboration across European Commission's services (inter-service groups)

How do synergies unfold?



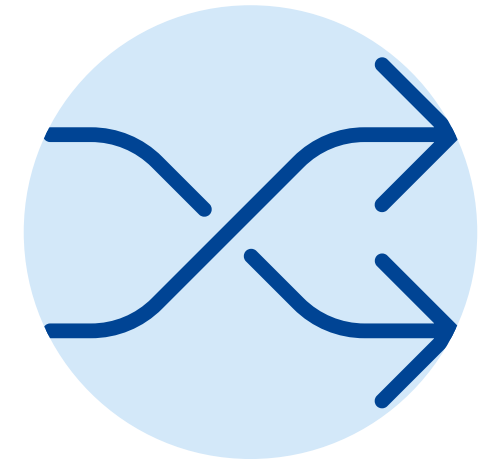
Complementary funding: bringing together funding from different programmes or different levels in the same project



Sequential funding: successive projects that build on each other (upstream / downstream)



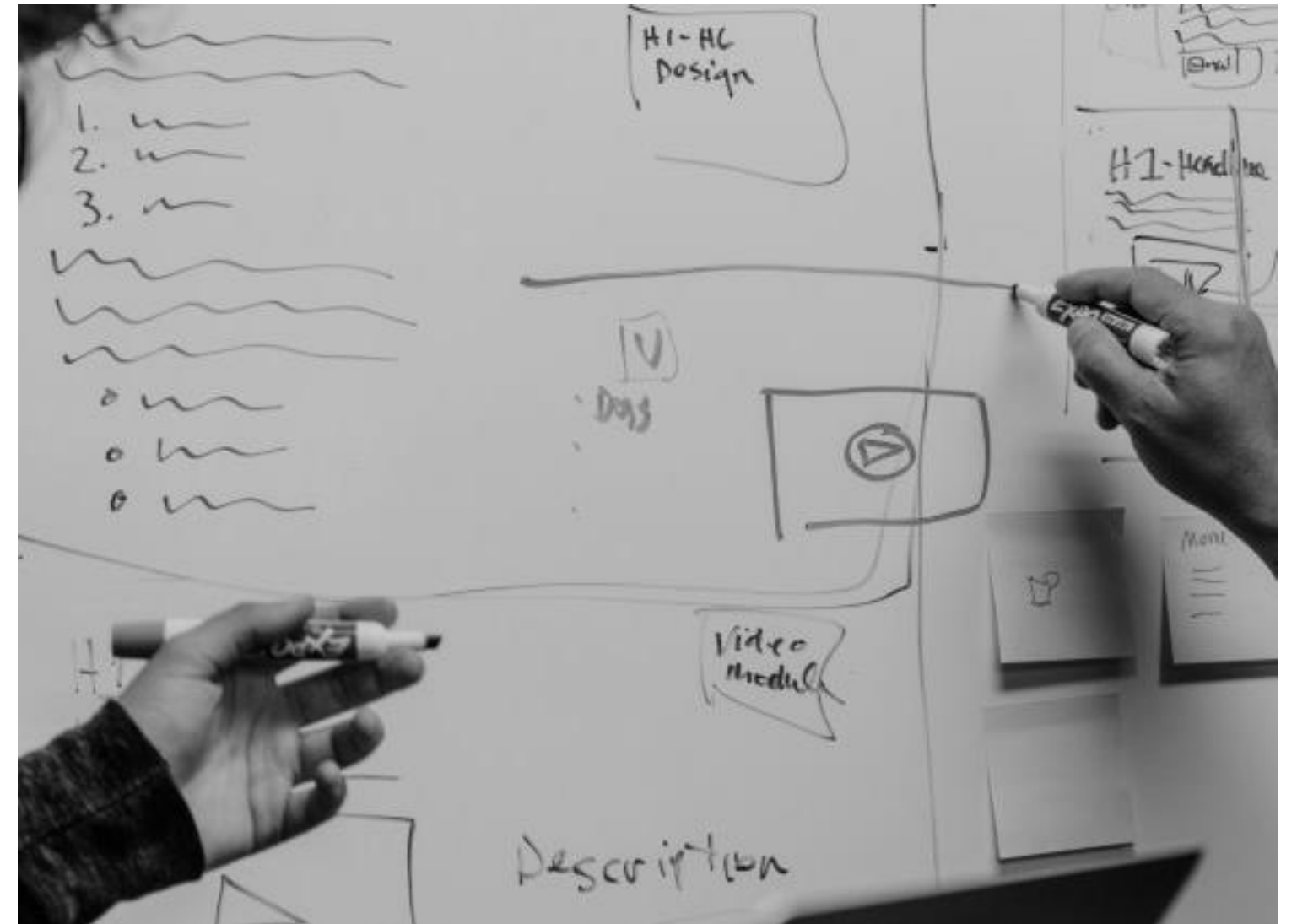
Alternative funding: taking up high-quality project proposals from other programmes (e.g. SoE)



Complementarity of parallel projects

How does HaDEA support synergies?

- **Constant dialogue** across colleagues working on similar and synergetic topics
- **Gathering beneficiaries** across cluster themes to exchange, avoid gaps and make recommendations
- **Mapping** of topics and colleagues working on them
- Promoting synergies through **beneficiaries and networks, participation in events, info days, strategic missions**
- Visibility and communication of cross-programme **synergetic results**
