

An ambitious EU budget for an ambitious Europe




National and Regional Partnership Plans: no one size fits all




National and Regional Partnership Plans

- **EUR 865 billion** – Investments and reforms
- Agriculture and fisheries – **EUR 302 billion** farmers income support and fisheries + doubled annual agricultural reserve
- **EUR 218 billion** min ringfenced for poorest regions
- **14%** social target within the Plans
- **43%** target for climate and environment
- Migration, border and security **3x** times
- EU Facility **2x**, including agricultural reserve **2x**, European Union Solidarity Fund **3x**
- Cushion - **EUR 8.7 billion**
- Catalyst Europe – **EUR 150 billion** in loans to Member States



FOCUSED

Steered towards EU's industrial and technological priorities

SIMPLER

One rulebook – same rules would apply within ECF and Horizon Europe.
Single portal - centralizing information on and access to all Union funding
Common rules for project promoters


IMPACTFUL

Support from research to scale-up
Unlocking private funding with more leverage on EU budget (ECF InvestEU Instrument)

Cross-border education, skills, culture and values

- **Erasmus+** will combine the current programme with the European Solidarity Corps.
- It will support the future **Union of skills**, reinforced to **41 billion (1.5x)**.
- **AgoraEU** will support media, culture and civil society with **EUR 9 billion (2x)**
- It will bring together Creative Europe and “Citizens Equality, Rights and Values”.
- Supporting a vibrant cultural, media and democratic space.



Building the Preparedness Union through the Union Mechanism

- The **Union Mechanism** will put in place our objective of preparedness by design.
- **Combining support for civil protection and health preparedness and response.**
- **EUR 11 billion** – a **x5** times increase to ensure faster and more effective response to wildfires, floods, pandemics, and other emergencies.

Next Steps

Next steps

- **MFF regulation** – adoption by unanimity of Member States and consent of the European Parliament (special legislative procedure).
- **Own Resources Decision** - adoption by unanimity in the Council, approval by national parliaments and consultation of the European Parliament (special legislative procedure).
- **Sectoral legislation** - ordinary legislative procedure (most cases) – adoption by the European Parliament and Council as co-legislators.
- **Negotiations on the MFF package in the Council** (MFF Regulation, Own Resources Decision and interinstitutional agreement) and sectoral acts have started under the Danish Presidency of the Council of the EU.
